### TREK TOUR PANORAMA

You can move freely, and let the lifts transport you to excursions which are suitable for everyone. Trek Tour Panorama will allow you to contemplate our magnificent mountains from above and to reach points of interest easily without using your car.





SCENIC VIEWS

When you find yourselves in the heart of the Dolomites, let the dream-like scenery fascinate you with its breathtaking panoramas which can be enjoyed from the 2,000m of the Ciampedie, up to the 2,950m of the Tarace of the Dolomites on top of the Sass Pordoi.



POINTS OF INTEREST

Enrich your day by visiting interesting places, such as the Great War Museum, the bronze Eagle, as well as mountain lakes, waterfalls, and highly peculiar rocky formations, or by walking along fascinating and interesting themed paths.



SUITABLE FOR ALL The possibility of reaching high altitude by cable car allows us to propose several easy hiking itineraries, which are suitable for the entire family and for those who are not used to walking long distances in the mountains, but who still wish to go hiking in the mountains surrounded by nature.



**OUR LIFTS** 

18 lifts, connected with each other, which are modern and safe offering panoramic views, will allow you to reach high altitude in just a few minutes. Panorama Pass and Dolomiti Supersummer are the tickets for unlimited access to all the lifts. You may also purchase one way or return tickets, as well.



LOVE FOR NATURE

Admire and respect nature by only walking on the indicated path trails, by putting your waste only in the specific bins, by letting flowers grow in the meadows and by avoiding to disturb animals with unnecessary noises.



PANORAMIC TOURS\*

They are ideal as first hiking trips, as they can be completed in half a day. The trails are mainly flat or slightly downhill or slightly uphill in some cases. However, they allow you to reach amazing panoramic spots and interesting places.



MODERATELY DIFFICULT HIKING EXCURSIONS\* These hiking trails are perfect if you wish to spend an entire day on the mountains surrounded by nature and by our magnificent Dolomites. Enjoy the satisfaction of reaching fascinating areas thanks to the combination of lifts and trails.



LONG HIKING EXCURSIONS\*

Long excursions require a stronger predisposition to more demanding hikes, since they usually take more than 3 hours to complete.



### LADY DOLEDA TOUR

From CANAZEI or ALBA

The trip on the Alba-Col dei Rossi lift is beautiful and panoramic. When you reach the top at 2,382 m you can enjoy a special 360° view: from Fedaia lake and Marmolada "the Queen of the Dolomites" to the Sella, Sassolungo and Catinaccio groups, made even more special thanks to the art installation of the legendary Dòleda countess, by the sculptor Andrea Dorigatti. The walk along the Avisio river is very easy and relaxing.



#### **COL RODELLA**

#### From CANAZEI or ALBA

WITH SHUTTLE SERVICE FROM PECOL TO PIAN DE FRATACES

This summer, the Campitello-Col Rodella cable car will be closed to allow construction of the new 3S lift system, which will enter service in the winter of 2025/26. The recommended alternative is as follows: from Canazei, take the 101 gondola to reach Pecol, or from Alba, use the combination of the Alba-Col dei Rossi 13O and Col dei Rossi-Pecol 102 cableways. From Pecol, a convenient shuttle service is available, which brings you to Pian de Frataces in 10 minutes using urban buses. From there, take the Pradel-Salei 155 gondola and the Des Alpes 152 chairlift to reach Col Rodella.




### **COL RODELLA**

From CANAZEI or ALBA

WITH THE LIFTS


As an alternative to the shuttle service, a combination of lifts is suggested, offering a scenic and evocative journey. From Canazei, you reach the Belvedere basin using the Canazei–Pecol 101 and Toé 104 gondolas. From Alba, the Col dei Rossi can be reached by cableway 130. After a short walk, you can take in sequence the Pian Frataces–Gherdecia 105 and Pradel–Salei 155 gondolas and the Des Alpes 152 chairlift to reach Col Rodella.



### **PASSO SELLA**

#### From CANAZEI or ALBA

Having reached the Belvedere basin by lift, the **Sella Pass** — the destination of this hike — is already visible on the opposite slope. A pleasant and cheerful stop at the **small lake in the Pian de Frataces area**. The arrival by cable car beneath the **slopes of the majestic Sassolungo Group** is particularly impressive. A gentle uphill walk leads to the Sella Pass.



## PASSO PORDOI

From CANAZEI or ALBA


Once you have reached the Belvedere-Col dei Rossi panoramic spot, you can take a walk to the **Pordoi Pass**, during which you will find the nice "Snow Queen" little church. If you follow a paved road, you will easily reach the **German Memorial** of the fallen of the War, which overlooks the Dolomites of the Veneto region and Col di Lana. Back to the Pordoi Pass you cannot miss the **Monument** to Fausto Coppi and the First World War **Museum**.



### CASCATE BASALTICHE

From CANAZEI or ALBA


The lifts take you to the Belvedere basin, accompanied by a magnificent view of the Sassolungo Group and the imposing Piz Ciavazes. Once you reach the small lake at Lupo Bianco (Pian de Frataces area), the descent begins towards the **Basalt Waterfalls**, named after the **hexagonal basalt columns** – a distinctive type of effusive volcanic rock.



#### CASCATE PIAN DE SCHIAVANEIS

From CANAZEI or ALBA

From Pian de Frataces, you can climb through the woods and reach the **green meadows of Roa**, a hay harvest area, where you will be able to see the **ruins of a cable station**, which during the First World War, used to connect the different strategic positions. When you reach the mountain's slopes, you will find the **Pian de Schiavaneis Waterfalls**, where crystal-clear water makes the clear Dolomites rocks look even whiter.

## **LUNAR TOUR**

#### From PASSO PORDOI

Once you have reached an altitude of 2,950 m you will find an easy **loop itinerary** on the plateau of the Terrace of the Dolomites. The path, immersed among the **moon like rocks** of Sass Pordoi, has an extension of almost 1 km and runs slightly uphill: it is highly recommended for anyone wishing to admire the panoramic horizon which spreads right across to the Austrian Alps as well as offering unique views over Marmolada, Catinaccio and Sassolungo. The moon like conformation, **ancient sea atoll** dating back 300 million years ago, is visible over the entire atoll and it is sometimes possible to catch sight of fossil remains.



### LA TERRAZZA DELLE DOLOMITI

From CANAZEI or ALBA


This is **the classical tour**, starting from Canazei or from Alba. When you reach Col dei Rossi you will be able to see the magnificence of the entire Sella Group and of **Sass Pordoi**, which is the destination of this excursion. There is a photography gallery at the cable car station of the Pordoi Pass which documents how the lift was built back in 1962. The ascent by cable car, which will take you to the **Terrace of the Dolomites**, at 2,950 m., in just 4 minutes, is very exciting. Right there, hikers will find themselves in a **breathtaking and amazing high mountain scenery**.



## CIAMPAC - SELLA BRUNECH

From CANAZEI

From Col dei Rossi, you will be able to admire the amazing chromatic and morphological contrasts between the white and intrepid calcareous Dolomites sides (Marmolada and Colac) and the milder and darker slopes made of lava and of volcanic materials (Crepa Neigra). In the Ciampac basin, children can have fun at the Ciampark playground.



TICKETS (PANORAMAPASS) (DOLOMITI SUPERSUMMER)



#### FORCELLA SASSOLUNGO

From CANAZEI or ALBA

From the Belvedere basin, you can already admire the famous Sassolungo Group, whose saddle appears beautifully nestled between the Sassolungo itself and the Five Fingers. The gradual approach by lift is particularly striking, taking you up to 2,685 metres into the heart of this prestigious mountain range. With a little imagination, one can picture how, around 250 million years ago, a coral reef once stood here, through which the sea of Tethys used to flow.



#### LAGO PIAN DA MUR

From CANAZEI or ALBA

The **new reservoir** at Pian da Mur truly offers an **exceptional panorama**: an enchanting view of the Sassolungo Group and of Piz Ciavazes. **A location** "d'Amur" (of love) – perfect for falling even more in love with the Dolomites. Along the route, one also passes the Pordoi lake, a historic postcard scene of the Fassa Valley. For the return, follow the gravel road called "Gluhwein" to reach Pian de Frataces, where you take the shuttle back to Pecol.



## **VAL JUMELA**

From **ALBA** 

Grazing animals, unspoilt nature and peace: all this is the Val Jumela, a little-known and almost untouched valley. Go up by cable car and then by chairlift to Sella Brunech (2.428 meters) and descend along the dirt road of Val Jumela, following the signs for path nr. 644. Along the way you will find Malga Jumela (1.978 meters), then go back up towards the Buffaure area (path nr. 643) and take the cable car to reach the village of Pozza di Fassa.



## GIRO DELLE OPERE D'ARTE

From POZZA DI FASSA

Just a few steps from the arrival of the Valvacin chairlift, you will find the **scenic butterfly-bench** overlooking the Sassolungo and Sassopiatto peaks. The descent is marked by **unique observation points**: the giant eagle, the oversized deckchairs and a pack of wolves. Upon reaching the plain, you can admire further **works by Franz Avancini**, such as the dragon and the bregostana (woodland witch) and enter the largest **wooden maze** in the Dolomites, which houses another giant sculpture. The hike ends at **King Laurin's thrones**, offering a breathtaking view of the heart of Val di Fassa. Return by cable car.



### **SULLE TRACCE DI CIAMPY**

From ALBA

Thematic route for families along the wonderful panoramic ridges that develop from Sella Brunech to Pian de Sele, just below the Crepa Neigra. Once you reach the Ciampac basin, you can collect the material at the info point and take the chairlift to the exceptional panoramic point of Sella Brunech (2,428 meters). From here you follow the various stages of the trail, discovering at each of them interesting curiosities about chamois and making friends with Ciampy, the Ciampac mascot.




## VAL SAN NICOLÒ

From POZZA DI FASSA

San Nicolò Valley is easily accessible **from the Buffaure area** too. From the gondola lift mountain station, hike up to the giant eagle, then follow the signs. A quick stopover on the panoramic natural balcony and you will start your descent through the woods until you reach **San Nicolò Valley**. Once there you can continue your hike and get to the **waterfalls** (on a one-hour slightly uphill path) or choose other trails. A shuttle bus service is available for the return to Pozza di Fassa.



#### PANORAMA TOUR

From ALBA

The hike along the ridge from Sella Brunech to Col de Valvacin, passing through the Sas d'Adam peak, allows you to contemplate all of the mountains of the Fassa Valley from a different point of view — you will enjoy a breathtaking panorama over the Sella Group, from Marmolada up to the Catinaccio and Sassolungo Group. Along the path, you will enjoy an amazing view of the fascinating San Nicolò Valley surrounded by the Monzoni Group. Comfortable descent to Pozza with the lifts, return to Alba using public transportation.



## **HIKE & BIKE**

#### From POZZA DI FASSA

This is a **circular tour of the Fassa Valley** that you can enjoy **using lifts, hiking and by bike**. Once you have reached Col de Valvacin with the chair lift, you can hike up to Sella Brunech surrounded by the breathtaking panoramas of the Dolomites. Once you have reached the valley at Alba, you can choose whether you wish to go back to Pozza by rented bike or using public transport. **Bike reservation** at the Pozza di Fassa ticket office is **mandatory**. ### GIRO SULLE CRESTE PANORAMICHE

From ALBA

Loop itinerary, starting and finishing at Alba di Canazei. From Ciampac you reach Sella Brunech, excellent panoramic point with a view over the Sella Group, Colac, the south Wall of Marmolada and the Catinaccio Group. Take the path which runs along the ridges towards Col Bel, another peak from where it is possible to enjoy a beautiful 360° view. Continue until you arrive at Malga Jumela in the marvellous Jumela valley. From here by walk and lift reach Col de Valvacin and along path nr. 613 head back to Sella Brunech to then get back to Alba by lifts.



### GIRO SULLE CRESTE PANORAMICHE

From POZZA DI FASSA

Circular tour on the ridges of the Val Jumela, green and not explored much. Starting from Col de Valvacin, you reach Sella Brunech and then Malga Jumela, along the viewpoints of Sas D'Adam and Col Bel. The return can be done by going up from the Malga to Buffaure and then descending by cable car, or on foot to Pozza di Fassa.



### **CREPA NEIGRA**

From ALBA

Once the cable car takes you to Ciampac, walk in the direction of the playground, on the right, where the path to Pian de Sele starts and continues along the slopes of Crepa Neigra, a mountain of volcanic origin, to arrive at the plateau overlooking the Val di Fassa and offering an incredible view of its majestic mountains. The return is along the same path.





## **GARDECCIA**

#### From PERA DI FASSA

By two chairlifts you reach Pian Pecei (1,800 m), where the **Path of Legends** starts, recalling a sequence of events of **King Laurin**'s life. The exploration does not end at Gardeccia and continues through the **Forest Path** to get to Ciampedie. Return to Pera by chairlifts or flying through the woods of King Laurin with the **Fly Line** (ticket to be purchased separately).



### **GARDECCIA**

#### From VIGO DI FASSA

From Ciampedie, by chair lift or by the exciting Fly Line, you can reach the woods and walk along the **Path of Legends**. Once you reach Gardeccia, you will have **an amazing view over the Catinaccio Group**: Torri del Vajolet, Dirupi di Larséc and Catinaccio d'Antermoia. The **Forest Path** completes this relaxing excursion.



## TOUR TE COA DE LA SCHIERÀTOLA

From PERA DI FASSA

Riding the 3 chairlifts provides a bird's-eye view of the forests. At Ciampedie, you can explore spruces, larches, and Swiss pines, where squirrels and other animals reside. With a gentle approach, you may witness them gathering ample food reserves hidden away in preparation for winter. This excursion suits all and offers insights into the habits and habitat of this cute little animal. Return via the chairlifts or experience a thrilling ride through the woods on the Fly Line (separate ticket required).



## TOUR TE COA DE LA SCHIERÀTOLA

From VIGO DI FASSA

Easy hike through the woods on the slopes of the Catinaccio Group where squirrels live. "Te coa de la schieratola" is actually the expression in the Ladin language for "in the squirrel's den". The trail winds around the Ciampedie plateau, enriched with informative signs about the habits and habitat of this cute little animal. Guided tours start every Tuesday and Sunday at 10:15 a.m. and last approximately 2 hours.



### **TOUR DEL CIAMPEDIE**

From VIGO DI FASSA

A **short tour** through this **extremely panoramic** UNESCO Natural Heritage site, which from Ciampedie and Pra' Martin allows you to admire the scenic view over the Fassa Valley, ranging from Latemar, Roda di Vael, the Sassolungo Group, and the Sella Group all the way up to Marmolada. A descent with the **Fly Line** will add a touch of adventure to this short but fascinating excursion.



### PRA' MARTIN

From PERA DI FASSA

By three chair lifts you arrive at Pra' Martin (2,095 m), a **breathtaking 360° panoramic spot**. Following the easy downhill path, you will reach Gardeccia. From there, the **Forest Path** leads to Ciampedie. The way back to Pera is by chair lifts or the first part descending by **Fly Line**. (Ticket to be purchased separately).




## L'AQUILA DI BRONZO

From PERA DI FASSA or VIGO DI FASSA

The "Vial de le Feide" path starts from Pra' Martin (2,095 m) and it takes you to Roda de Vael. You can comfortably proceed along the wide Hirzelweg path and thus reach the monument dedicated to Theodor Christomannos: a 3-meter-tall bronze eagle located on a panoramic position over the Fassa Valley and the Ega Valley. You can go back along the Alta Via dei Fassani path up to Ciampedie.
